At HIPPY Halton, we promote and believe in change as a way of growth and development. We empower HIPPY parents to make positive changes in their parenting practices and believe in themselves as their children's first and best teachers. Research shows that parental involvement improves children's performance in all areas, and these effects remain in the future even if parents become less involved as their children grow.

HIPPY is built on the premise that mothers are the mechanism for change in their families and communities. Determined by a wish to ensure the most promising future for their children and with support, mothers can overcome many obstacles.

As an evidence-based program that works with families in their homes to support parents, our home visitors started to visit our families in person, with 18% of the visits at home, while 82% were still virtual home visits. This year, our goal is to visit the HIPPY families in person. At HIPPY, we value the benefits of building relationships with our families and supporting parents as they acquire new skills and abilities essential to strengthening mother-child relationships.

Life brings changes, and our home visitors move forward and grow, progressing to other job opportunities or enhancing their education. Thanks to these changes, we can keep supporting our HIPPY mothers by giving them their first Canadian work experience as they join our team of home visitors.

We celebrate the fact that 87% of the HIPPY parents completed the 30-week program last year! We served 172 children, and 55 children headed to start Grade 1. This is a great accomplishment!

Through our Reading Campaign, we promote the importance of reading to our children from the time they are born. This year, we distributed 900 books among 300 families in Halton.

- We are grateful for the continued support from our dedicated team of home visitors for their passion and commitment to doing their work, empowering HIPPY parents to prepare their children for success at school and beyond.



How Do HIPPY and SMART Programs Work?



Outcomes:

- Parent-child relationships are strengthened

- Their first Canadian job gives them skills and workplace experience

Quick Facts

Home Visitors Overview 2022/23:

- Home Visitors speak 8 languages and earn a Living Wage
- Home Visitors received a total of 1343 hours of training
- 90% of the current team started as HIPPY Mothers

HIPPY Halton Families:

- Our families come from 27 countries and speak 25 languages other than English
- Families achieved a record 87% completion rate
- 75% of Parents report that their awareness of child development has increased



Program Delivery Highlights:

- 100% of parents reported that they feel confident teaching their children new skills




Our Operating Costs
